ALEXANDER GRAHAM BELL (1847-1922)

U.S. inventor and physicist, inventor of the telephone, was born in Edinburgh, Scotland, on March 3, 1847. He was educated at Edinburgh University and the University of London, and because of illhealth, moved with his father to Canada in 1870. In 1872 he opened a School in Boston for training teachers of the deaf and also gave instruction in the mechanics of speech. The following year he became professor of vocal physiology in Boston University. In 1876 he exhibited an apparatus embodying the results of his studies in the transmission of sound by electricity, and this invention, with improvements and modifications, constitutes the modern telephone. He was also the inventor of the photophone, an instrument for transmitting sound by vibration in a beam of light, and of photographic apparatus. Later, he interested himself in the problem of mechanical flight. He gave numerous addresses and published many scientific monographs. Bell was the founder of the American Association to Promote the Teaching of Speech to the Deaf, and of the Volta Bureau for the increase in knowledge relating to the deaf. He was for a time President of the National Geographic Society and was appointed a regent of the Smithsonian Institution in 1898. He died on August 2, 1922, at his summer home near Baddeck, Nova Scotia.
